

# OVERVIEW OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC

As the most significant international biological threat in the past 100 years, this brief introductory section presents the June milestones of the COVID-19 pandemic.

analysis is based the consultation of various reliable international open sources (found and International available on the Organization Maritime IMO. Key international actions and procedures to fight the virus and better deal with the increasing concerns are also presented below.




# OVERVIEW OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC



- Over the month of December, an average 4 million new cases were reported globally per week, meaning a slight decrease compared to the previous period. Data should be interpreted with caution owing to the end-of-year holiday season (numbers may be influenced by reporting delays).
- Recent reports of different variants of SARS-CoV-2 have again raised interest in and concern about the impact of viral changes. In the last months, two different variants of SARS-CoV-2 have been reported to WHO as unusual public health events from the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, referred to as VOC 202012/01, and the Republic of South Africa, named 501Y.V2.
- Preliminary epidemiologic, modelling, phylogenetic and clinical findings suggest that SARS-CoV-2 VOC 202012/01 has increased transmissibility, and preliminary data also indicates that there is no change in disease severity.

# OVERVIEW OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC



- In the past week, over 130 000 new cases were reported in the African Region, a 13% increase compared to the previous week, and over 3000 deaths, a 4% increase over the previous week. South Africa reported the highest number of new cases (93 978 new cases; 1585 new cases per 1 million population).
- In the **Region of the Americas**, the number of new weekly cases remained at similar levels to last week with over 1.9 million new cases and 32 000 new deaths reported. The highest new case counts were reported in the United States of America (1 325 424 new cases, 4004 new cases per 1 million).
- The **Eastern Mediterranean Region** reported over 154 000 new cases and over 3000 new deaths, a decrease of 1% and 12%, respectively compared to the previous week. Cases and deaths in the Region decreased for the sixth consecutive week. The highest number of new cases were reported from the Islamic Republic of Iran (42 511 new cases, 506 new cases per 1 million)
- The **European Region** continues to report a large number of cases with over 1.5 million new cases and 3200 new deaths, a 3% decrease and 2% increase compared to the previous week, respectively. New weekly cases have decreased for the past two weeks. Last week, the country reporting the highest number of new cases was the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (343 784 new cases, 5064 new cases per 1 million).
- New cases and deaths in the South-East Region have continued to decrease, a trend observed since early September. Just over 200 000 new cases and 3700 new deaths were reported this week, a 10% and 3% decrease respectively, compared to the previous week. The country reporting the highest number of new cases and new deaths was India (136 115 new cases; 99 new cases per 1 million; 1813 new deaths; 1 new death per 1 million).
- There has been little change in the number of new cases (just under 53 000) reported in the Western Pacific Region, while new deaths increased by 10% (over 700) compared to the previous week. The plateau in new cases over the past week comes after four weeks of increasing trends. The country reporting the highest number of new cases this week was Japan (23 642 new cases; 187 new cases per 1 million)





**Summary** – The Egyptian Commercial Service (ECS) estimates that export opportunities available in the country's chemical and fertiliser industries stand at about \$2bn in the 37 countries in which it operates, according a recent study by the entity.

# HIV

**Event -** Central African Republic faces critical HIV situation.

**Summary** – Doctors Without Borders (MSF) reported that half of CAR's estimated 110,000 people living with the virus are under antiretroviral treatment. The situation is more alarming for children under the age of 15 who are aware of their HIV status, but less than a quarter of them are under treatment. The CAR is also dependent on insufficient external funding for its response to HIV.

# SARS-CoV-2

**Event -** New lineage discovered.

**Summary –** The South Africa National Institute for Communicable Diseases (NICD) announced changes in SARS–CoV–2, the virus which causes COVID–19. The Network for Genomics Surveillance in South Africa (NGS–SA) reports detecting a new lineage, which is a group of mutated viruses, of SARS–CoV–2 in the Eastern Cape, Western Cape and KwaZulu–Natal Provinces. This lineage possesses between 10–20 mutations that were not previously seen in viruses from South Africa prior to September 2020.

# **Yellow Fever**

**Event** - Outbreak update.

**Summary –** A total of 50 cases were reported from the health district of Koundara in north–west Guinea, one from the health district of Dubreka (near Conakry, in the south–west) and one from the health district of Kouroussa, in the center of the country. Analysis performed at the Nongo, Conakry Laboratory of Viral Hemorrhagic Fevers revealed that 10 cases of suspected YF were IgM positive for YF. Of these, 8 were from unvaccinated suspect cases from Koundara, 1 was from Dubreka, and 1 from Kouroussa.

# **Chemical Weapons Declaration**

**Event -** Syria's Chemical Weapons Declaration contested.

**Summary** – Syria's initial declaration of chemical weapons on its territory cannot be considered accurate and complete, the head of the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW) said during a Security Council videoconference meeting on 11 December, while Damascus and its allies insisted that those stockpiles had been confirmed all destroyed by 2014.

# TECHNOLOGICAL INNOVATIONS

<u>SYnergy of integrated Sensors and Technologies for urban sEcured environment</u>
(<u>SYSTEM</u>) is a 42-month, € 9 million **H2020 project** coordinated by Fondazione FORMIT involving the participation of other 22 partners, amongst whom is OSDIFE.

Started in September 2018, it aims at developing and testing a **customised sensing system for hazardous substances detection** in complementary utility networks and public spaces which are tested and adapted in six urban areas.

During 2020 the project kept carrying out a number of testing and deployment activities despite the many limitations posed by the COVID-19 pandemic. Many field testing activities were expected to be jointly carried out to deploy the wide variety of sensing devices, thus testing the network as combination of different technological solutions sending data to a centralised monitoring centre.

Due to the limitations imposed to the EU Member States from the very beginning of the year to cope with the disease spreading, local working groups were set up, each including the technology providers and the stakeholders settled in each city to keep working on site. It is against this backdrop that from June onward local lab and field testing activities were carried out in Bratislava, Lavrio, Idstein, Latina and Rome.

Locations where to deploy sensing devices were agreed with the local law enforcement agencies and the utility network operators making them available, and testing activities were held to deploy such technologies in real environment to test them and their Technology Readiness Level (TRL) in the application scenarios agreed. In case of impairment to travel, online training sessions were carried out after shipping the technologies to be tested in another country for the same purpose. Further to this, video recordings and additional material were prepared and discussed with the Research Executive Agency (REA) during the review meeting held online in September 2020.

A wide variety of activities have been planned to further foster the interaction with the project stakeholder groups, thus being provided with relevant suggestions and feedback on how the SYSTEM products and services can go to the market.

## **Remote Weapon Station**

**Event -** Rafael's latest Samson Integrated RWS enters production.

**Summary –** Israel's Rafael said its latest-generation Samson 30 mm Integrated Remote Weapon Station (RWS) has entered production for an unidentified export customer. The turret consists of a modular aluminium structure to which an appliqué armour package can be fitted, depending on customer requirements. The Samson Integrated RWS's main armament is a Northrop Grumman Armament Systems 30 mm MK44S dual feed cannon, and a 7.62 mm co-axial machine gun (MG). The 30 mm cartridge cases are ejected outside of the turret after the MK44S has been fired. A typical ammunition load would be 220 rounds of 30 mm and 500 rounds of 7.62 mm ammunition, according to the company. The MK44S fires a complete family of 30x173 mm ammunition, including air bursting munition (ABM) rounds, and the weapon can be converted to fire 40x207 mm ammunition.
